During five days of training there will be master classes, workshops, talks and performances designed to let you or your company work at your own pace. Each day starts with yoga and a vigorous warm up. You will then have the opportunity to participate in one or two hour classes throughout the day in basic and advanced acrobalance, tumbling, trapeze, tight wire, slack rope, tissue, spanish web, chinese pole, hand stands, hula hoop, dance, juggling, clown and performance technique, to mention but a few.

BE INSPIRED

You will learn from the best circus artists around including Aidie Delaney, Elouise Green, Mark Sands & Jeff Turpin. Work on individual skills, have your act workshopped by experts and have the opportunity to perform at the bee-bop-a-blue-bar cabaret.

Over 30 trainers will converge at Lone Star from around Australia and the World to share their knowledge. Most sessions in the training programme require a reasonable level of fitness and experience.

THE SITE

Set amidst the beautiful Panama Forest, 50 km from Launceston, the peaceful valley of Lone Star, with its park like setting and home to abundant wildlife is the ideal venue. Established in 1990, the well laid out site is remote, yet comfortable.
