Getting There

Training takes place at the Circus Festival site, Golconda, 50km north east of Launceston. FLY: All major airlines fly direct from Brisbane, Sydney and Melbourne to Launceston. If you notify us by email before Jan 5th we can book you on a shuttle bus from airport/Launceston to the site on Jan 29th. DRIVE: The Spirit of Tasmania transports vehicles from Melbourne to Tasmania. From Launceston take the East Tamar Hwy, through Lilydale and just follow the signs. CYCLE: We promote cycling to the festival by offering to transport your equipment from Launceston and provide undercover shelter for your bike. CAR POOL: Log onto our partner car pool web site to give or get a lift: www.coolpooltas.com.au

Accommodation

The Circus Festival site is set in a vast state forest and is a very beautiful place. Although remote, without mains electricity or corner store, there is a well priced organic restaurant, café and the ever popular bee-bop-a-blue-bar. Unless staying in Launceston (1 hr drive), Bridport or Scottsdale (30 min drive) you will need to bring a tent or camper van. If you would like a list of local accommodation or want to hire one of our tents, then do let us know. We provide camping facilities, basic showers etc.. Please remember this is a zero waste site, which means we recycle but you are responsible for removing your hard rubbish. This is a truly pristine environment, so only organic soap and shampoo.
